- First year students and seniors: Please clearly state in your Cover Letter why you are applying and, if a senior, explain whether you will be able to fully complete a year-long term and if not why.
- Any majors are welcome.
- Interest in the nonprofit/philanthropy sector.

Answer *any* of the following questions (you **do not** need to answer all of the questions.) Please be brief. One page, single-sided maximum with proper Cover Letter headings:

- 1. What is your relationship to Frederick? Have you lived in Frederick your whole life? Are you from out of state?
- 2. Why are you interested in volunteering at the Ausherman Family Foundation?
- 3. What do you hope to gain from this experience?
- 4. Why is philanthropy or nonprofit work important to you?

Location

Board of Trustee meetings are, currently, held in a large conference room in the Civil War Museum of Medicine. In-person participation is highly encouraged.
