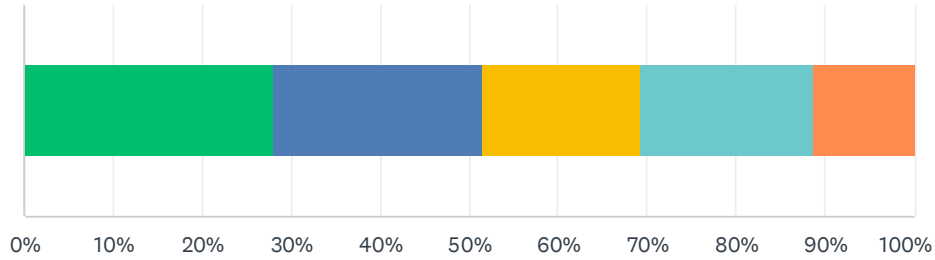


# Q1 Please respond to this statement: Overall, Frederick County offers me a lot of transportation choices.

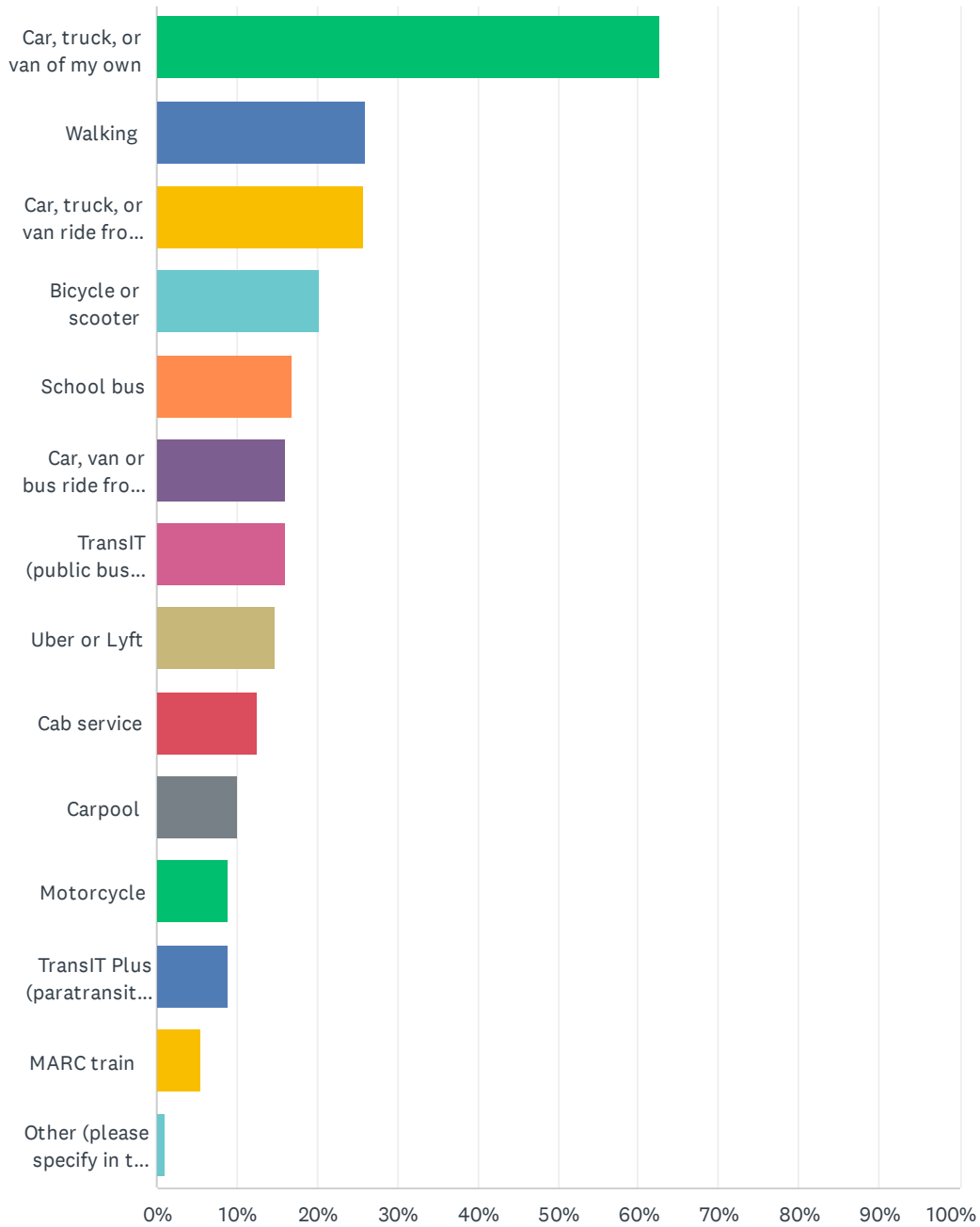

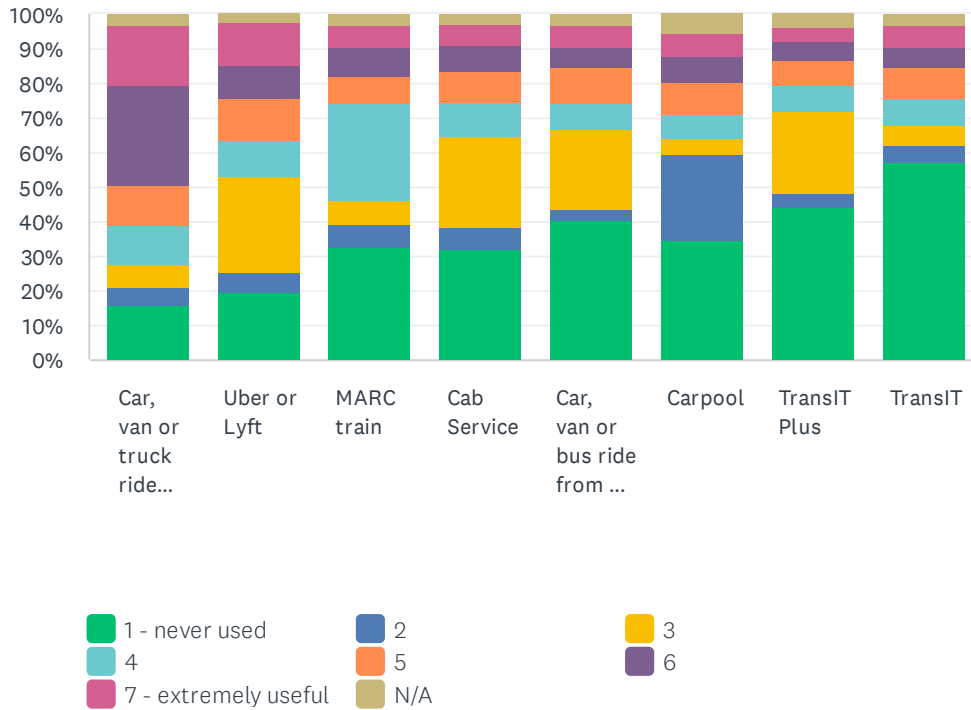
### Q3 In a typical month, which of the following forms of transportation do people in your household use? (Check all that apply)

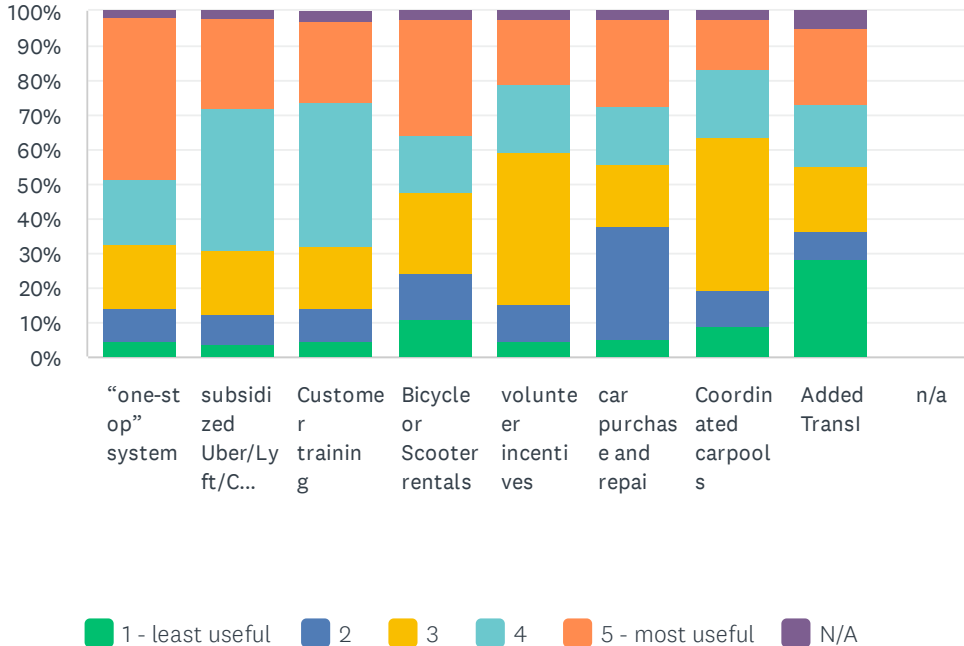

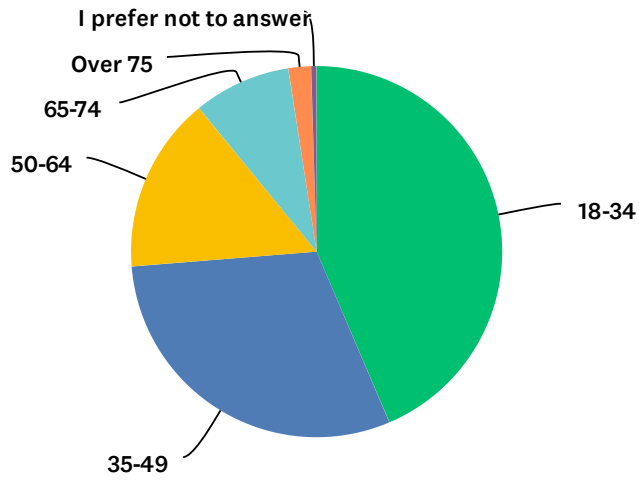

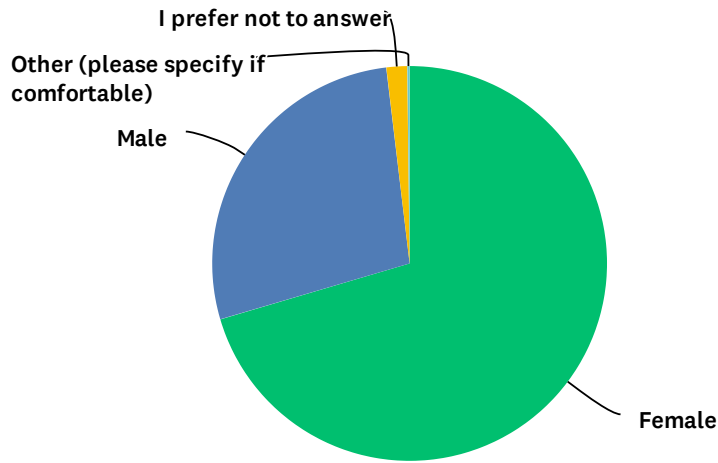

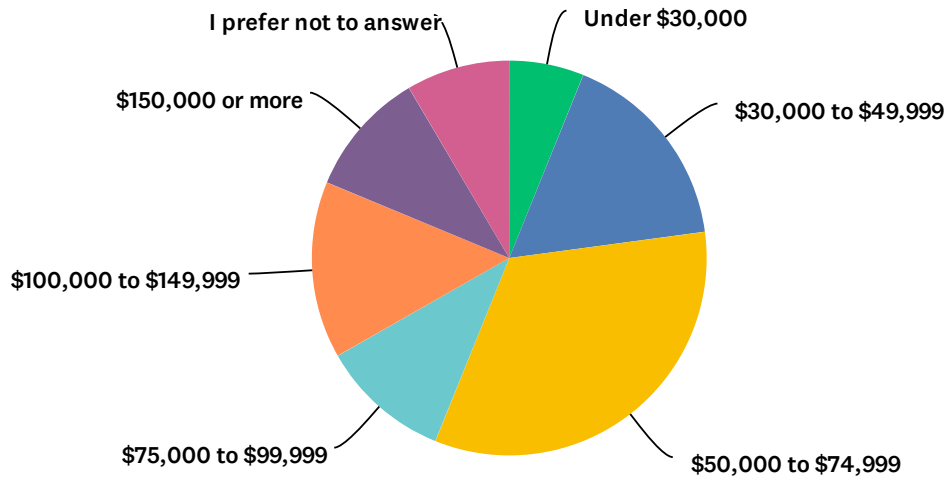

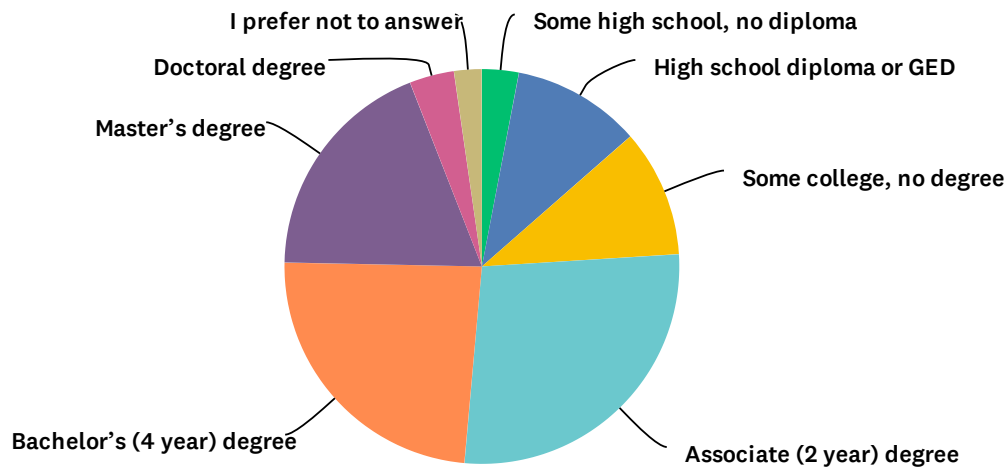

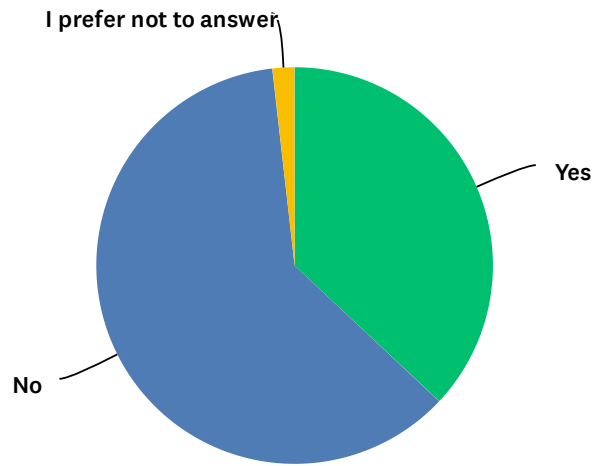

### Q13 Are you a Veteran?

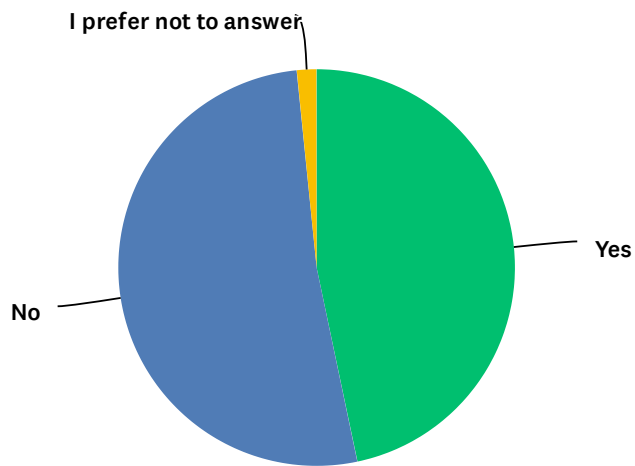
